

Committed to Safety: Campus Cleaning Guidelines for the 2021-2022 School Year

The Conejo Valley Unified School District will continue to maintain the highest standards to protect the health and well-being of our students and staff on our campuses. In accordance with [the most current Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\) guidelines](#), our cleaning protocols will include the following, recommended daily procedures:



ALL ROOMS:

General cleaning will continue for classrooms, kitchens, restrooms, common areas, and offices with trash emptied, touchpoints wiped, sweeping/vacuuming, and mopping where necessary.



HIGH-TOUCH POINT CLEANING:

A disinfectant cleaner will be used on door handles, drinking fountains, and handrails, as well as any other frequently touched surfaces. Outside lunch tables will be washed down and disinfected daily.



RESTROOM PROTOCOLS:

Staff will check all active restrooms every two hours and will continue to clean according to current CDC guidelines. Paper towels, toilet paper, soap, hand sanitizer, etc., will be replenished as needed.



ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT:

Portable wash sinks and hand sanitizing stations will remain at all sites. They will be checked throughout the day and serviced/replenished as needed.



POSITIVE NOTIFICATION:

Student or staff members testing positive will activate disinfecting protocols. In addition, all common areas and classrooms will adhere to CDC guidelines:

- *If less than 24 hours have passed since the person diagnosed with COVID-19 has been in the space, we will respond immediately to clean and disinfect the area.*
- *If more than 24 hours have passed since the person diagnosed with COVID-19 has been in the space, no additional cleaning (beyond regular cleaning practices) is needed.*

CVUSD will continue to monitor current CDC guidelines, and our dedicated Maintenance & Operations team will remain flexible to adapt to protocol revisions and directives.
