SCHOOL CHOICE Information and Planning for the 2017/2018 School Year

Conejo Valley Unified School District (CVUSD) has many educational options to offer the community from preschool through adult education. Most children in kindergarten through grade 12 attend their assigned "neighborhood" school based on their address of residence. If you are interested in investigating alternative placement, you may learn more about our schools and programs by visiting the CVUSD website at www.conejousd.org, which includes links to all of our schools' websites.

HIGH SCHOOL (Grades 9-12)

Students currently attending 8th grade at CVUSD middle schools will automatically be transferred to their neighborhood high school for 9th grade based on their address of residence.

A SCHOOL CHOICE Application 2017/2018 should be submitted only for:

- students currently attending 8th grade who wish to attend a school other than their neighborhood high school for 9th grade, or
- students currently attending 9th, 10th, or 11th grade who wish to transfer to a different high school.

Century Academy

Century Academy is an online, blended learning middle and high school that offers UC A-G approved courses, is NCAA approved and offers up to 19 Honors/Advanced Placement courses. While online learning is a significant component at Century Academy, it also has a blended learning environment where teachers teach in a traditional classroom style to support students. It offers a flexible schedule to meet the needs of students seeking flexibility in their school schedules. New opportunities are now available for 7th and 8th grade students at Century Academy.

MIDDLE SCHOOL (Grades 6-8)

Students currently attending CVUSD K-5 elementary schools will automatically be transferred to their neighborhood middle school for sixth grade, based on their address of residence.

A SCHOOL CHOICE Application 2017/2018 should be submitted only for:

- students currently attending a K-5 elementary school who wish to attend a school other than their neighborhood middle school for 6th grade, or
- students currently attending the 5th grade at Sycamore Canyon School who wish to attend a different school for 6th grade, or
- students currently attending a middle school who wish to attend a different middle school, or
- students requesting to transfer into or out of DISCOVER Academy.

DISCOVER Academy (Grades 6-8) at Sequoia Middle School – Apply through School Choice

DISCOVER Academy is a school within a school that offers the advantages of both traditional and small learning communities. Using engineering and applied sciences as interdisciplinary themes, the academy stresses hands-on, innovative, and inquiry-based instruction to encourage a lifelong love of learning in students.

Century Academy

Century Academy is an online, blended learning middle and high school that offers UC A-G approved courses, is NCAA approved and offers up to 19 Honors/Advanced Placement courses. While online learning is a significant component at Century Academy, it also has a blended learning environment where teachers teach in a traditional classroom style to support students. It offers a flexible schedule to meet the needs of students seeking flexibility in their school schedules. New opportunities are now available for 7th and 8th grade students at Century Academy.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Students currently attending CVUSD K-5 elementary schools will automatically be re-enrolled in their current school, regardless of their address, as long as they live within the CVUSD boundaries.

A SCHOOL CHOICE Application 2017/2018 should be submitted *only* for:

- students currently attending a K-5 elementary school who wish to attend a school other than their current school, or
- students currently attending a K-5 elementary school who wish to return to their neighborhood school (based on address of residence), or
- **incoming students (including new Kindergarteners) who wish to attend school with their sibling(s) that are attending a school not in their neighborhood (based on their address of residence), or**
- students requesting to transfer into or out of Earths Magnet School and/or Open Classroom Leadership Magnet, or
- students that wish to attend Transitional Kindergarten (birth date between 7/1/2012 and 12/2/2012)

Transitional Kindergarten Program – Apply through School Choice

Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is a developmental, hands-on instructional program. TK will be available at Acacia, Aspen, Cypress, Glenwood, Madrona, Weathersfield, Walnut, Westlake and Westlake Hills (subject to change based on enrollment). The district may admit into the TK program a child whose fifth birthday is 7/1/2012 through 12/2/2012. TK hours will be the same as Kindergarten. Apply by submitting a School Choice Application (see page 3). Before and after school child care may be applied for through CVUSD Child Care. A Transitional Kindergarten Parent Information Meeting is scheduled on **Thursday, January 26, 2017, 6:30 p.m.**, in the **Acacia Elementary School Multipurpose Room**, 55 W. Open Classroom Leadership Magnet (Grades K-5) – Apply through School Choice

The Open Classroom Leadership Magnet program consists of five multi-grade classes and involves families in the academic and social-emotional development of their child. This whole child approach teaches that each child has unique gifts and innate strengths that, when nurtured, brings forth a child's true leadership potential. The program is held at the Conejo Elementary School site. EARTHS Magnet (Grades K-5) – Apply through School Choice

The Environmental Academy for Research Technology of Earth Sciences (EARTHS) is designed to help students acquire the tools of inquiry and expression by delving deeply into subjects with a cross-curricular approach. SHINE (Specialized Home Independent Neighborhood Education)

KINDERGARTEN ELIGIBILITY

In order to enroll in Kindergarten for the 2017/2018 school year, a **child must be 5 years old by September 1, 2017**. If your child is born 7/1/2012 through 9/1/2012, your child is eligible for Kindergarten or Transitional Kindergarten (see page 2 for information).

REGISTRATION BEGINS FEBRUARY 1st FOR GRADES K-12

If you reside in CVUSD and your child will be a new CVUSD student beginning in the 2017/2018 school year, please register at your neighborhood school **during the week of February 6, 2017**. You will need the following to complete registration: an original birth certificate, immunization records, and two current utility bills that show your service address and mailing address on each bill. If you apply for School Choice to another school and the application is approved, the registration documents will be forwarded to the approved school.

SCHOOL CHOICE

Parents of children who reside in CVUSD who want their child to attend a CVUSD school other than their neighborhood school in the 2017/2018 school year (for any of the reasons listed above) may apply for "School Choice" beginning Monday, February 1, 2017. For the 2017/2018 school year, the timeline is as follows:

- **Between 2/1/2017 and 3/1/2017 (5:00 p.m.), submit the School Choice Application 2017/2018**
 - **The application will be available beginning February 1st** at all school sites, the District Office and on the District website: www.conejousd.org
 - In order to be included in the lottery, the application must be received by 5:00 p.m. on March 1st

- Applications received in the Instructional Services Department by the March 1st (5:00 p.m.) deadline will be entered into a lottery if the number of applicants exceeds school choice capacity

- By March 31, 2017, a letter will be mailed to on-time applicants for middle & high school stating if the application is approved – OR – identifying the wait list number assigned to the applicant.
 - By April 28, 2017, a letter will be mailed to on-time applicants for elementary school stating if the application is approved – OR – identifying the wait list number assigned to the applicant.
 - Late* applications may be submitted:
 - By August 23, 2017 for elementary and middle schools (except as noted below)
 - By the 7th day of school for high school 1st semester
 - Between 12/1/2017 and 1/5/2018 for high school **second semester** transfer for 9th, 10th and 11th grade students only who have not already submitted a School Choice Application 2017/2018
 - By January 31, 2018 for Open Classroom Leadership Magnet
 - By May 11, 2018 for Transitional Kindergarten
- *Applications received after the March 1, 2017, 5:00p.m. lottery deadline are considered late and will be placed at the bottom of the wait list in the order received. NO PRIORITY will be given for late applications. The likelihood of approval is reduced for late applications.**
- As of September 29, 2017, 5:00 p.m., the wait list for the 2017/2018 school year K-12 will be cancelled and no school choice transfers will be processed thereafter (except as noted above).
