Transitional Kindergarten 2017-2018

For the 2017-2018 school year, the District will offer Transitional Kindergarten for our students who miss the cut-off date to enroll their student(s) in kindergarten.

- Transitional K students have birthdates September 2, 2012 to December 2, 2012.
- Students whose birthdates fall between July 1, 2012 and September 1, 2012 are eligible for either TK or Kindergarten.
- The program will be located at each of the following campuses (***subject to change based on enrollment***):

Aspen Elementary, 1870 Oberlin, Thousand Oaks

Cypress Elementary, 4200 Kimber Dr., Newbury Park

Walnut Elementary, 581 Dena Drive, Newbury Park

Weathersfield Elementary, 3151 Darlington Dr., Thousand Oaks

Westlake Elementary, 1571 E. Potrero Rd., Westlake Village

Westlake Hills Elementary, 3333 S. Medicine Bow Ct., Westlake Village

- Transitional K will be the same hours as Kindergarten.
- Transitional K will be taught to Kindergarten standards, but Transitional K will incorporate a different learning approach based on the developmental needs of those students.
- Assessments will occur throughout the year to track progress.
- After completion of Transitional K, students will be assigned to Kindergarten at their neighborhood school.
- For parents seeking a preschool experience, CVUSD offers preschool programs to facilitate entry into Kindergarten: Wonder at University Center, Neighborhood City Center, Neighborhoods for Learning, and Horizon Hills Adult Education Parent Participation Program.
- Before and after school child care may be applied for through CVUSD Child Care. For information regarding the CVUSD Child Care program visit their website at www.cvusdchildcare.com or call 805-492-3567.

How To Apply For Transitional Kindergarten

2/1/17 to 3/1/17 (5:00 pm) Beginning 2/1/17, the *School Choice Application 2017/2018* is available at all school sites, the District Office and on the District website: www.conejousd.org . In order to be included in the lottery, the **application must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, 3/1/17, in the Instructional Services Office**, 1400 E. Janss Road, Thousand Oaks, 91362 (rear building) or faxed to 805-379-5756.

By 4/28/17

A letter will be mailed to every on-time applicant stating if the application is approved -- OR -- identifying the wait list number assigned to the applicant. If the application is approved, then the parent may register at the approved school.

***3/2/17 to 5/11/18**

Late TK applications may be submitted to Instructional Services but will be added to the bottom of the wait list formed by on-time applicants. *The chance of approval of your first choice will be greatly reduced, as the requested TK school(s) may already be full.*

*Note: The late school choice application date listed above only refers to TK. Late application dates differ between grade levels and programs. You may find the complete list of late school choice application dates on our District website www.conejousd.org

Frequently Asked Questions

- Will transportation be provided? No.
- Will child care be available? CVUSD Child Care may available through a parent pay program.
- Will classes be balanced by gender? Every effort will be made to balance the classes to avoid a classroom of mostly boys or girls.
- Will my child have to move campuses after completing the Transitional K program? Yes, students will be assigned to kindergarten at their neighborhood school. If a parent would like their child to attend a school other than their neighborhood school, they will need to submit a School Choice Application.
