Mr. Kohlmeier outlined the services of RAIN Communities. Primarily, the organization offers housing to families who are temporarily homeless. The program includes housing as well as daily counseling for parents and children. If there is an emergency, RAIN will temporarily place families in a hotel. Mr. Kohlmeier emphasized that the County will not take kids away from

their parents just because they do not have a home. Additionally, every effort is made to bus the kids to the school they are currently attending.
