COVID-19 SCENARIO CHART: STUDENT CLOSE CONTACTS

Close Contact* - No Symptoms

Unvaccinated, Unmasked

- Quarantine at home.
- Quarantine can end after Day 5 if asymptomatic and a test (*laboratory-based OR at-home*) collected on Day 5 or later is negative **OR** Quarantine can end after Day 10 if asymptomatic.



Close Contact* - No Symptoms

Vaccinated, Masked/Unmasked

No quarantine is necessary for vaccinated students, either masked or unmasked, as long as they have no symptoms of COVID-19, and proof of vaccination is provided.



STUDENT TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Per updated VCPH isolation guidance (*released 1/7/22*): stay home for at least 5 days. Isolation can end after day 5 if symptoms are not present or are resolving AND a laboratory-based OR at-home test is collected on day 5 or later tests negative.

If a Close Contact* has symptoms: Immediately, remove from school, isolate at home.

Close Contact* - No Symptoms

Unvaccinated, Masked

SCHOOL SETTINGS ONLY

(MODIFIED QUARANTINE)

**** Both the exposed student and the student with COVID-19 were wearing a face mask during the whole time of close contact.**



Close contacts who develop symptoms of COVID-19 must:

1. Get tested for COVID-19
2. If positive they must isolate per the "Student tests positive for COVID-19" guidance in the center of this chart.
3. If negative test they should continue quarantine and return only if fever free and symptoms have improved.

- Continues to attend school, as long as they remain asymptomatic and continue to wear a face mask, as required.
- Does not participate in extra-curricular activities in school or community setting.
- Test twice weekly during quarantine.
- Modified Quarantine can end after Day 5 if asymptomatic and a test (*laboratory-based OR at-home*) collected on Day 5 or later is negative.

*Please Note:

Day 0 = first day of symptoms, day of testing and/or last day of contact with COVID positive (*whichever date is earliest*).
Day 1 = first day after the above.

*Close Contact is defined as within 6 feet for 15 cumulative minutes within a 24-hour period of someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

**The information in this chart is determined by guidance from the California Department of Public Health and Ventura County Public Health.



- * If unable to test or choosing not to test, and symptoms are not present or are resolving, isolation can end after day 10.
- * If fever is present, isolation should be continued until fever resolves.
- * If symptoms, other than fever, are not resolving continue to isolate until symptoms are resolving OR until after day 10.
- * Wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings.
