



The most common unit of measurement for energy management is energy use intensity (EUI). The U.S. EPA ENERGY STAR program defines EUI as – “The energy consumed by a building relative to its size.” This Energy Trend or EUI Chart shows monthly normalized energy usage for electricity and gas, in global energy units of BTU’s per square foot of building space.

The orange trend line shows the running average of the prior 12 months. We strive to see an orange line that over time trends downward to the right, meaning that the EUI is improving (lower is better; energy intensity is declining).
