To start your Majors journey...

1. Beginning fall 2014, you will receive task assignments via Naviance (a college/career-readiness online software) that correspond to Majors requirements. Naviance email is how we communicate with you about the Majors.
2. Click on the Naviance logo on the TOHS website and login.
(If you do not have a Naviance account, click "I need to register" on the right hand side and login with your student ID. Fill in the required information to create an account.)
3. Go to My Planner -> Tasks assigned to me -> the starred items are required tasks and include the Majors requirements.
4. Click on individual tasks to learn more about how to complete each task.
5. Check your email regularly for notices about Majors meetings and opportunities.
