The following list has been revised over the years as we see a need. **We strongly recommend that every student have these materials for the school year.**



	one or two 3-ring notebooks (at least 2-inch rings)
	wide rule binder paper
	Colina assignment notebook provided by the school
	a minimum of 15 subject dividers – Do not write on them before you see your teacher
	1-2 zipper pouches(fabric pouches are more durable) or pencil boxes
	a minimum of 2 blue or black ball point pens
	2 highlighters
	pencils
	eraser
	one box of Kleenex for your homeroom teacher – More is always welcome!

**Once classes begin, your individual teachers may ask for other supplies.
All materials must fit into your school locker.

wear-and-tear and usage.**
