

## 2021 – 2022 Redwood ASB/Leadership for 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

The ASB/Leadership class at Redwood is a year-long elective open to 7th and 8th grade students, by application only, who are highly motivated to improve their leadership skills by their involvement in classroom activities, student government, developing leadership and communication skills, and planning and participating in a variety of student activities, including spirit activities and community support.

### Course Goals:

- ~To develop responsibility, self-confidence, initiative, creativity, leadership and school pride.
- ~To allow students to participate in and manage extra-curricular activities.
- ~To encourage productive student-faculty relationships.
- ~To develop positive school/community relationships and peer/peer relationships.

### Student Expectations:

- ~Students are expected to exemplify qualities of being a good leader such as: being responsible, dependable, accountable, trustworthy, understanding, and energetic.
- ~Students will be expected to present themselves as positive role models of Redwood Middle School.
- ~Students are expected to be available at various times before, during, and after school to participate in student activities.
- ~Students who do not meet the above expectations and do not maintain Renaissance status will be placed on a probationary contract and may be dropped from the class.
