Common Planning Time (CPT) Days & Advisory Days

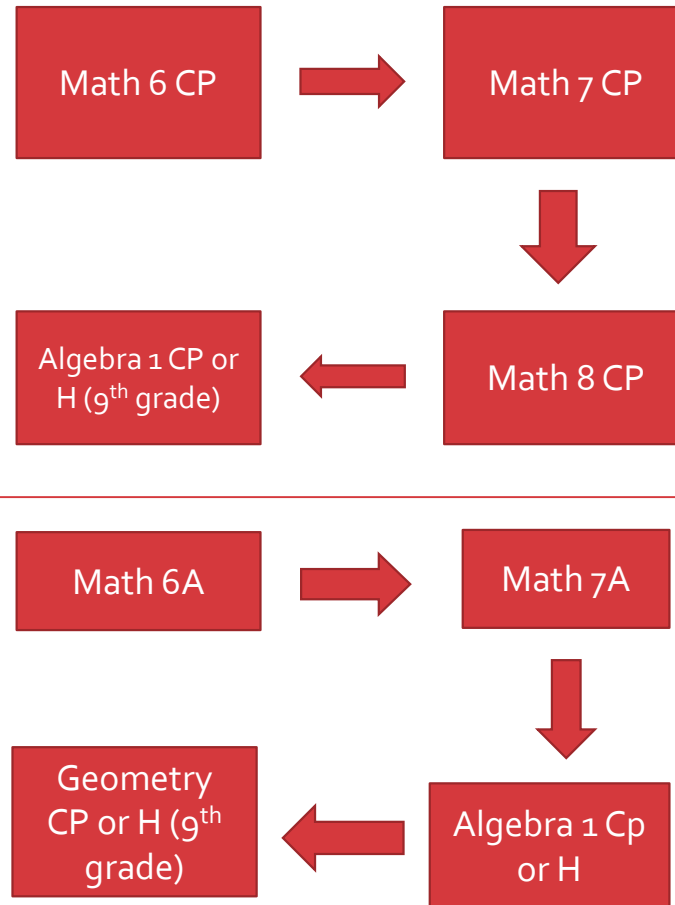
- Tuesdays are Common Planning Time days. School starts at 9:30 a.m. for all students and there is no A period class on Tuesdays. Students leave school at their typical scheduled times, either after 5th or after 6th period.
- Wednesdays and Thursdays are Advisory days. All students have Advisory period from 9:00 a.m.- 9:25 a.m. on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Students with A period will attend A period before Advisory and students starting period 1 will start their day at 9:00 a.m. with Advisory before going to period 1.

Honors Pathways for 7th and 8th Grade Students

- All 7th and 8th grade classes are offered at the College Prep (CP) level.
- 7th grade students who earn A's or B's all three trimesters in English 7 H OR all A's all three trimesters in English 7 CP AND the requisite score on the District Benchmark exam will be automatically placed in English 8 H.
- 7th grade students who earn A's or B's all three trimesters in Social Science 7 H OR A's all three trimesters in Social Science 7 CP AND the requisite score on the District Benchmark exam will be automatically placed in Social Science 8 H.
- 7th grade students who earn A's all three trimesters in Science 7 CP AND concurrent or prior enrollment in Algebra 1 CP or higher, will be automatically enrolled in Physical Science 8 H.
- 7th graders who earn A's or B's all three trimesters in Math 7 Accelerated as a 6th grade student will be enrolled in Algebra 1 H.
- 7th graders who earn A's or B's all three trimesters in Algebra 1 H as a 7th grader, will be enrolled in Geometry H as an 8th grader.

- Summer Boost Camp and Get Ahead Program
- Students who earn A's all three trimesters in Math 6 CP will typically be offered the boost camp opportunity
- Students will then complete an assessment and, if they score high enough, they will be able to move to Math 7 Accelerated
- These opportunities are typically available between 7th and 8th grade

Redwood EDGE Program

- The 7th-grade EDGE program will consist of English and science classes. Together, the student with their EDGE teachers and classmates will collaboratively support the student's journey by collecting and analyzing information while, at the same time, developing communication skills. Public speaking and scholarly writing for a real-world audience along with research skills within an intellectual, innovative and nurturing environment will be emphasized. The 7th-grade EDGE program will strengthen and extend critical thinking, independent research skills, and collaborative teamwork focusing on problem solving. After completing the 7th-grade EDGE program, the student will then continue their studies in 8th-grade as a member of the English/social studies EDGE cohort.
- The 8th-grade EDGE program will be your social studies and English classes. Together, the student with their EDGE teachers and classmates will collaboratively support the student's journey by collecting and analyzing information while, at the same time, developing communication skills. Public speaking and scholarly writing for a real-world audience along with research skills within an intellectual, innovative and nurturing environment will be emphasized. The student will then, hopefully, continue their studies by applying to The Center for Advanced Studies and Research, a three-year program at Thousand Oaks High School, beginning in 10th grade.
- The 7th- and 8th-grade EDGE Cohort classes will encourage students to innovate, create, collaborate, embrace challenges, explore through inquiry, see multiple perspectives, think critically and learn from failure while practicing a growth mindset.
