STUDENT ENTRY

Notes

Back gates by science building and softball fields will be closed. Upon drop off, encourage your student to access the gate with the fewest number of students in line.

Students will be screened upon entry (temperature, symptom check-list questions) and will be provided hand sanitizer. Arrows indicating screening check-points will be visible on ground.

No parents on campus unless a prior meeting has been arranged. Parents must enter through the main gate for temperature screening and a list of COVID-19 health screening questions.

Gates by softball fields will be closed. Students are encouraged to maintain 6 ft social distancing when exiting campus and waiting for parents to pick up.

SPECIALIZED PROGRAM

Student Entry:

Specialized Program Bus enters on Camino Manzanitas. Para meets students at bus and perform screening once students have exited bus. Para meets students dropped off in front parking lot by parent at the main gate. Campus Supervisors take temperature check and ask health screening questions.

Dismissal:

Specialized Program Bus picks up students on campus from side science lot on Camino Manzanitas. Students to be dismissed for parent pick up at meet paraprofessionals at the main gate. Paras will accompany students to the science gate for bus pick-up.

RESTROOMS

Bathroom Assignments:

6th Grade = C Bathroom
7th Grade = E Bathroom
8th Grade Girls = I Bathroom
8th Grade Boys = I Bathroom

Notes

Bathrooms will be monitored by campus safety assistants during the school day. Soap, hand sanitizers and paper towels will be available. Handwashing and physical distancing signs will be displayed.
