

6th Grade Frequently Asked Questions

(Don't worry; your teachers will go over this with you plenty of times!)

How do I find my locker?

On the bottom left-hand side of your schedule look at the last 3 digits. Then go to page 15-17 in your Agenda Book to locate your locker location and school map.

Where do I go my first day of school?

Starting the day before school starts, we will have the name and classroom number of your first period teacher posted at the back of the school. We will also have the first period teacher lists posted on our website. www.conejousd.org/loscerritos

Where do I get my full schedule?

Your first period teacher will give you your full schedule on the first day of school.

What if I'm late to my first class?

Don't worry if you're late. We'll understand.

How do I find my classes on the first day?

You can use your school map located on pages 16 and 17 in your Agenda Book. We will also have leadership students and teachers help students find their classes on the first day.

What if I can't open my locker?

Find the nearest teacher or campus supervisor and we'll help you.

Do I need to change into my PE clothes for PE the first day?

No. Your PE teacher will let you know when you need to start changing into your PE clothes.

Where do I go to buy lunch?

Your 4th period teacher will lead you to the lunch lines and the lunch area.

When will I be able to go to bathroom?

Your teachers will inform you of when you may use the bathroom during class. You are also able to use the restroom during passing periods and lunch.

When will I get to meet all the sixth grade teachers?

Good news! We have a free Sixth Grade Ice Cream Social just for you on September 14th right after school in the auditorium.

What do I do with my backpack?

You keep your backpack/ school bag in your locker at all times during the school day. Your teachers will let you know which supplies to bring to class.

Do I have to bring my books to school?

No. Your teachers have class sets of textbooks. The textbooks you receive at orientation stay at home.

Where do I go if I have a problem with my schedule?

First, ask your teacher and he/she will assist you and may direct you to the counseling office.
