- Grad Nite GOODNITE, an exclusive showing of World of Color just for Seniors

Tickets: On sale from March 13th to 31st in the Student Store only. Tickets will cost \$120 w/ASB and \$130 without ASB sticker from March 13th-17th, \$130 with ASB and \$140 without ASB from March 20th-March 24th, \$140 with ASB and \$150 without ASB from March 27th to 31st. Cash, credit or debit only. No checks. Student Store hours are 7:30am to 3pm.

Time: Busses will load at 11:30am on June 7, 2017. Prepared food is not allowed on the busses. Unopened, packaged snacks are allowed on the busses. Note: No food allowed at Disneyland.

Grad Nite is for WHS Seniors only. All students must ride buses provided to and from Disneyland.

The following Disneyland rules apply:

All persons, bags, parcels, clothing and other items may be subject to screening/security checks at the Park entrances and also within the Parks. (*WHS rules prohibit backpacks. Purses only.*)

Proper attire, including shoes and shirts, must be worn at all times.

The WHS Dress Code applies to Grad Nite attire.

Dress Code

Attire that is inappropriate at Disneyland, and which may result in refusal of admittance or ejection:

- Costumes and/or masks may not be worn by guests 14 or older (unless they are for medical purposes).
- Clothing with objectionable material, including obscene language or graphics.
- Clothing which, by nature, exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment.

OVER 

Prohibited Items

The following items are prohibited at Disneyland Grad Nite:

- All outside food and drinks including factory sealed water bottles

Guests may bring empty plastic or aluminum water bottles to be filled at water fountains throughout the parks. Quick service dining locations are able to provide complimentary cups of water upon request.

- Selfie sticks (hand-held extension poles for cameras and mobile devices)
- Glass containers including small glass perfume/cologne bottles
- All types of markers and highlighters
- Alcoholic beverages and any illegal substances
- Weapons of any kind, or objects that appear to be weapons (also including toy blasters, squirt guns, etc.)
- Self-defense equipment (pepper spray, mace, stun guns)
- Restraining devices (e.g., handcuffs, zip ties) or any suspicious items (e.g., box cutters, razor blades, duct tape, wire)
- Items that may be disruptive to other park guests (e.g., laser pointers, slingshots, stink bombs, air horns, wireless speakers, silly string)
- Tobacco products including electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), vaping products, marijuana products, and medical marijuana. The Grad Nite private event at *Disney California Adventure* Park is a completely non-smoking event.
- Recreational devices such as drones, remote control toys, wagons, skateboards, scooters (motorized and non-motorized), inline skates, shoes with built-in wheels, tricycles, unicycles, motorcycles, bicycles, and pogo sticks
- Suitcases, coolers or backpacks, with or without wheels, larger than 24" long x 15" wide x 18" high (61cm x 38cm x 46cm)
- Sporting goods or equipment (e.g., baseball bats, helmets, hockey sticks, golf clubs, bows and arrows, camping equipment, chairs, stools, tables and Frisbees)
- Sharp or pointed accessories that may cause injury
- Masks and makeup that could be construed as part of a costume
- Other items determined to be harmful or disruptive
