Grading

Grades in this course are given in three categories:

1. Tests/Quizzes/Projects – These account for roughly 80% of your grade in this course.
2. Homework – This accounts for roughly 10% of your grade in this course
3. Semester Final – This accounts for roughly 10% of your grade in this course.

Please note that the final has very little bearing on a student's overall grade in the class. The final will only help/hurt students who are border line in the class.

Homework

Homework is given every day. Assignments are usually no more than 20 minutes in length and are posted on the text book website. Full credit is given for completed assignments. **No partial credit is given for incomplete or late homework.**

HW Make Up

When a student returns to school after an absence, they must bring the completed homework assignment from the last day they were present in class. Homework assigned on the day the student was absent may be turned in for full credit no more than 2 days after their return to school. If a student is absent for multiple days, more time may be allowed for making up assignments based on arrangements made with the teacher. It is the student's responsibility to get the missing assignments from the internet or a classmate.

Test Make Up

Test make-ups must be completed within one week of the date the test was given. Names of students who miss an exam will be written on the board and will be erased once the make-up exam has been taken. A student's absence must be excused before being allowed to make up a test. Tests that are not made up within 7 days will be scored as zero. **Students who are truant on the day of the exam will automatically receive a score of zero on the exam.**

You will find the link to the textbook website on my WHS page. **When viewing Q, please note that a blank space represents an assignment or test missed due to absence. These count as zeros (F) until the assignment is made up.** A "0" on Q indicates an assignment that was either not turned in or incomplete on the day it was due. These assignments cannot be made up.

Extra Credit

There will be several extra credit opportunities each semester in the form of vocabulary words from the Cultura sections of the textbook. Extra credit given will not exceed 1% of the overall grade.

Behavior
