2. Student Council Report: Representatives were just elected, no report given.
3. SSC Representatives:
 - The committee nominated James Stafford to continue to be the Chairperson, Amy Cann to continue to be the Secretary and for Beth Saltzberg to become the DAC representative. Vollmer moved and Callahan 2nd.
4. Review of old business:
 - Approval of previous minutes: Vollmer moved, Callahan 2nd.
5. DAC Report given by Amy Cann
 - 'Look Within' is the Reflections theme this year
 - The Saving Hearts Foundation is doing free heart screenings at WHS on 10/19.
 - Inclusive Schools Week is first week of December.
 - FMLA allows parents to take time off to attend IEP meetings.
 - September is library card sign-up month. City employees will be visiting various kindergarten classrooms in the district. The library will also be continuing their 'Reading Buddies' program this year to help improve reading skills.
 - Over \$5 million was spent on Measure I projects this summer.
 - The district is piloting two books for ELA adoption for K-5. Decision will be made in spring.
 - Discussion about SPSA and the roll the SSC should play in developing a plan. Due Nov. 30th.
6. New Business/ Principal Report
 - The week of September 23rd is 'Hello Week'. TOHS cheerleaders will be greeting students when they arrive. Mrs. Vollmer will be showing a video and doing activities in each classroom.
 - Measure I: The landscaping is finished. In November Mrs. Vollmer will be meeting with District representatives to look at new modular buildings to replace the portables and resurface the existing buildings.
 - The 1st and 4th grade classrooms are piloting the new ELA textbooks.
 - LCAP Goals/Budget: Mrs. Vollmer divided up the 4 LCAP goals amongst the SSC members and they were reviewed to see which areas our school could improve to meet SPSA goals.
 - Mrs. Vollmer is continuing to work on the Comprehensive School Safety Plan.
7. Committee Reports
 - GATE (Bouchard): Gate testing has been moved up to December. Tentative 'Spont Day' will be 9/25. Odyssey of the Mind meeting will be held September 26th. There will be GATE activities once a month, open to all students. A letter will be sent home to all GATE families to allow them to opt-in for the GATE newsletter.
