# Parking Rules and Regulations

Thousand Oaks High School initially provides student parking for ONLY 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students based on availability. At the start of second semester, any remaining permits will be offered to 10<sup>th</sup> grade students through a lottery. Students must purchase a valid permit yearly. Student permits are only valid in the student lot. Students parking in a staff lot will be assigned a Saturday Work Study and may lose student parking privileges.

The school assumes no responsibility for theft or damage to personal property. A parking ticket may be placed on cars parked illegally on campus. Thousand Oaks High School is not responsible for lost or stolen parking passes. REPLACEMENT PASSES WILL NOT BE ISSUED. Take extra care at the car wash and when transferring a vehicle.

### Student's Responsibility:

Students may park only in marked spots in the designated student lot. Students shall display parking permit in lower left-hand corner of the windshield when parked on campus during the school day. All vehicle codes will be enforced on and around campus. Violators may be cited or towed. The parking privilege will be revoked if the parking permit is loaned, sold, or given to another student. Parking privileges may be revoked at any time.

### **Consequences for violations:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense: Student will be assigned a Saturday Work Study. •
- 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> offense: Student will be assigned a Saturday Work Study. Vehicle will be towed if parked in red zone or unmarked spot. •
- 4<sup>th</sup> offense: \_Vehicle will be cited, off-campus suspension may be assigned, vehicle may be towed, and parking privileges will be revoked for the remainder of the school year.

### Consequences for violations in the staff Lots:

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense: Student will be assigned a Saturday Work Study. THIS permit application is the warning.
- Subsequent offenses: Students will be cited, towed, and/or assigned Saturday Work Study. Parking privileges will be revoked for the remainder of the school year.

Vehicle Code rules apply on and around our campus. Any student identified by school administration as driving recklessly or with excessive speed on the streets adjacent to TOHS or on school property will have the parking privilege revoked immediately and may be suspended from school. Student vehicles parked on district property are subject to search per CVUSD Board Policy 5145.12.
