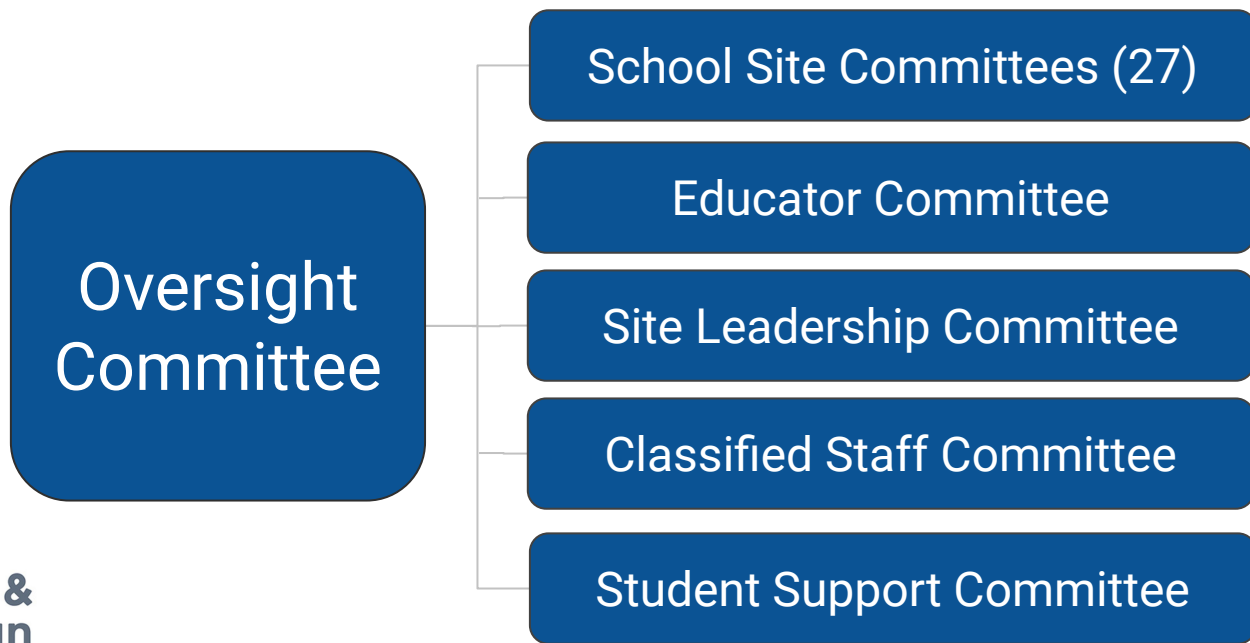

- Account for varying resources and supports at home

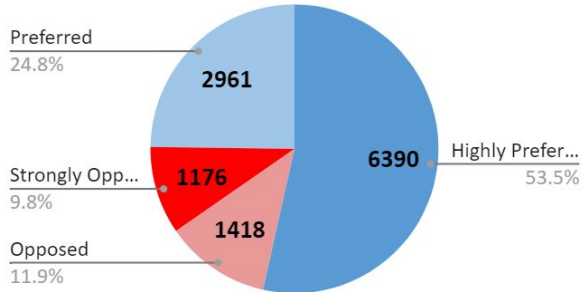
# Survey Analysis

- **12,183 families** completed CVUSD's "Fall 2020" Family Survey from May 15th to May 20th. Surveys were received in English and Spanish.
- **4,845 students** (Grades 5-11, Post-Secondary) completed CVUSD's "Fall 2020" Student Survey from May 15th to May 21st.
- **766 certificated staff** completed CVUSD's "Fall 2020" Staff Survey from May 15th to May 19th.

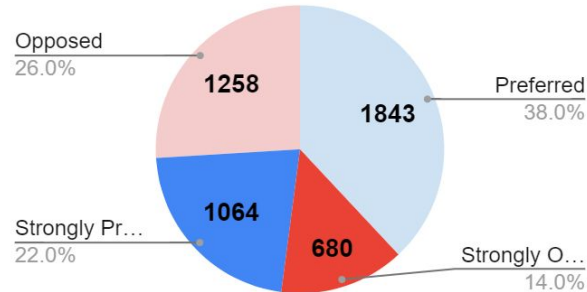
# Family Survey Analysis

- **78%** of CVUSD families prefer Traditional, in-school learning. **Nearly half** of all families strongly prefer this model.
- **60%** of CVUSD families prefer Hybrid Teaching and Learning.
- **32%** of CVUSD families prefer Remote Teaching and Learning.

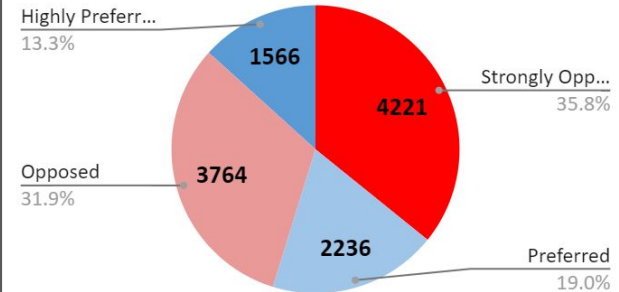
## Traditional Model - Preferences

# Family Survey Analysis

- The following aspects of remote teaching and learning were rated as “Very important” or “Important”:
  - **90%** - Frequent feedback on student progress
  - **84%** - Synchronous/“live” lessons or meetings with teachers
  - **75%** - Synchronous/“live” virtual office hours
  - **73%** - Asynchronous assignments that can be accessed online anytime



# Family Survey Analysis

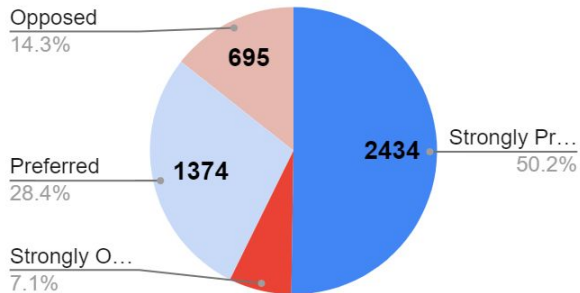
Frequent comments on how we might best implement and enhance remote teaching and learning, if needed, in Fall 2020.

- Support student mental, social-emotional health

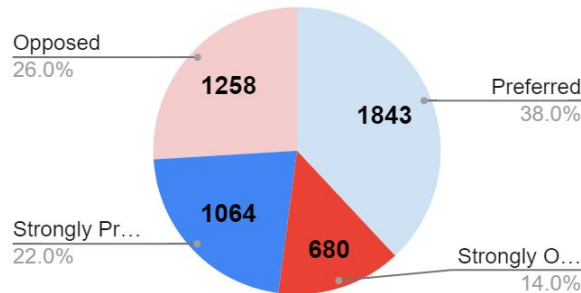
# Student Survey Analysis

- Students **most prefer** the traditional model with fewer preferring hybrid and the least preferring remote teaching & learning.

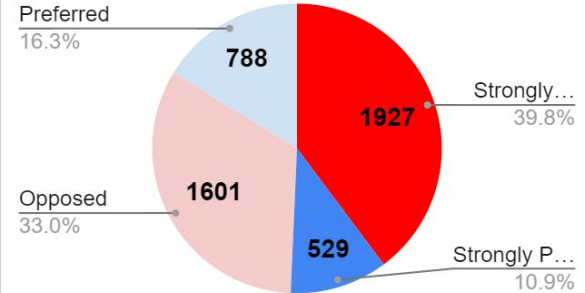
## Traditional Model - Preferences

# Student Survey Analysis

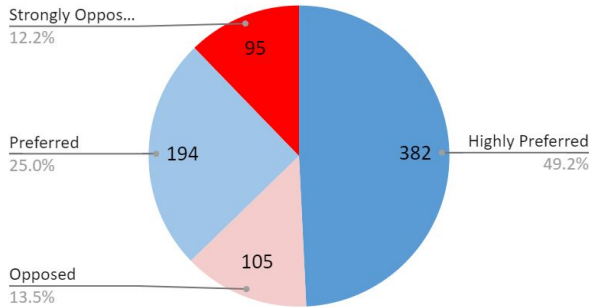
**Student Survey: Frequent comments on how we might best implement and enhance remote teaching and learning, if needed, in Fall 2020.**

- Want a common online learning platform throughout the District

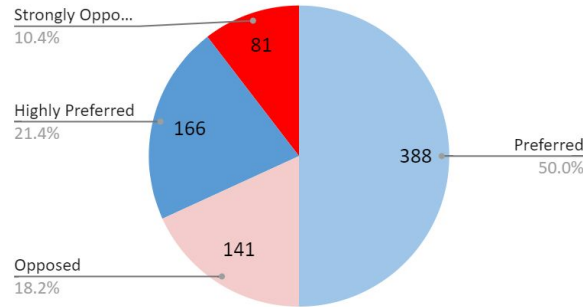
# Staff Site Survey Analysis

- **74%** of teachers prefer (25%) or highly prefer (49%) traditional teaching.
- **71%** of teachers prefer (50%) or highly prefer (21%) hybrid teaching.
- Remote teaching is the least preferred option, but still 228 teachers preferred and 131 highly preferred this option.
- Google Classroom is the most preferred platform (62%); SeeSaw is second (21%)

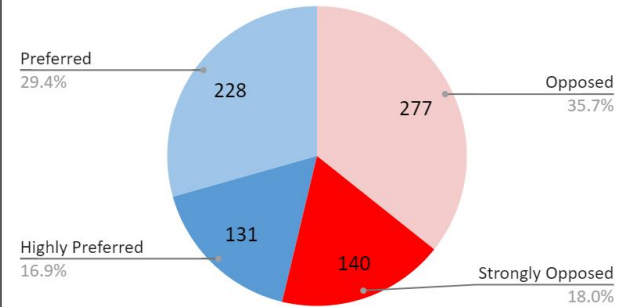
Traditional Model: All CVUSD Certificated St...

# Staff Survey Analysis

**Staff Survey: Frequent comments on how we might best implement and enhance remote teaching and learning, if needed, in Fall 2020.**

- Accountability with traditional grades and attendance
- Teachers with varying circumstances at home - options for them
- Include some hard-copy, paper/pencil materials
- Purchase software and platform subscriptions
- Training for parents on platforms
- Support a common online platform by grade-span



# Latest Public Health Orders

## *May 19 CDC Guidelines for Reopening Schools*

- Maintain at least 6-feet physical distance from other persons
- Desks should be 6-feet apart and all facing the same direction
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces between uses
- Supported by May 22 Ventura County Public Health Orders

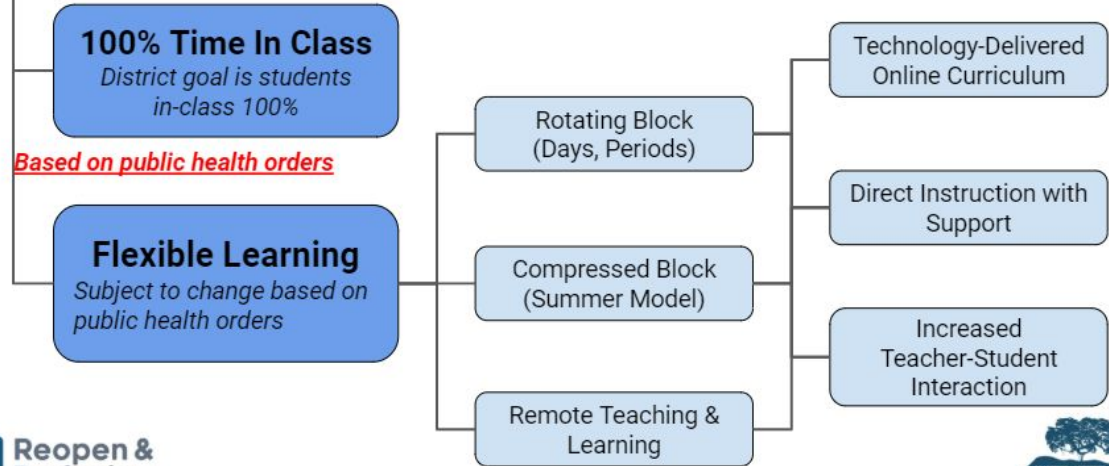

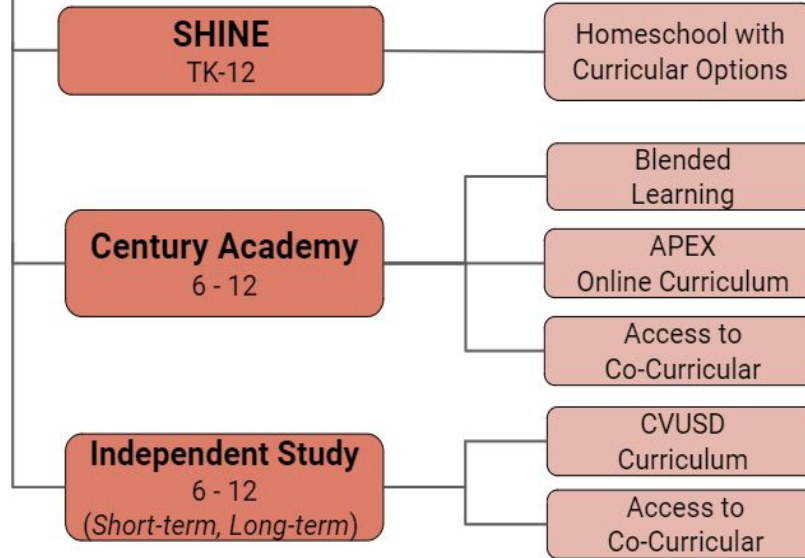

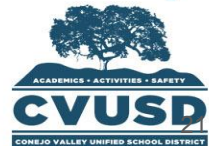
