- Programs are for uninsured, individuals who are ineligible for other programs (Medi-cal) or can't afford other health care programs
- Food distribution on Wednesdays at 3:00 pm. First come, first serve, no sign-ups. They will give away food until it's gone. Can drive-thru or walk-up. They regularly have free clothing and household items.
- Free medical clinic, chiropractic care, mental health counseling, nutrition counseling, vision care and glasses, immunization, and emergency dental care. Staff will start meeting with individuals at 5:00 pm, but the people start lining up at 4:00 pm. This is also first come, first served.
- STAT 600+ Uninsured people screened for High Blood Pressure and Diabetes in the community annually. You want to identify while in the early stages. Making lifestyle changes or pharmacological intervention can reverse, prevent, and/or delay these medical conditions.

## COVID-19 TESTING

The County of Ventura offers no cost COVID-19 testing for residents of Ventura County.

#### Symptoms of COVID-19 can be:

- · Cough or shortness of breath
- OR other symptoms: fever greater than 100.4°F, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell

#### Close contact means:

- · Sharing a home
- . Being closer than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes without wearing a mask
- . Having contact with the bodily fluids (spit, blood) of the sick person through coughing, sneezing, sharing utensils
