Progress Monitoring – Pacheco:

 - 6th grade went from 26% to 39%
 - 7th grade from 26% to 27%
 - 8th grade from 28% to 35%
- 8th grade science 231 students took the test Mean 80%. Most trouble was Interpreting Line Graph only 65% correct.
