Progress Monitoring – Klinger:

- California Dashboard States' accountability system for school (measures: state testing english/math, EL student progress, suspension rate, chronic absenteeism)
- Shared progress from 2021/22 and 2022/23.
 - Chronic Absenteeism went down in 2023

- Suspension Rate went up by 0.5%.
- ESL Progress went up 8.5%.
- EL Arts Went down 6.5 points above standard.
- Math went from 18.5 points above standard to 8.7 points above standard. Only school in the district to be above standard.
- Semester 1 Grade data will be reported in February as well as department benchmark/assessment information.
