# What is ELO-P?



# ELO-P is...

The Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P) is funded by the state of California to create and/or support enrichment programs for students in TK-6th grade.

The CDE defines ELO-P as a before school, after school, or non-school day learning program which focuses on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on and engaging learning experiences.

## The Law

California *Education Code (EC)* Section 46120 amended by AB 181 (Chapter 52, Statutes of 2022) and AB 185 (Chapter 571, Statutes of 2022).



# Let's Break it Down

## Days

180 school days + 30  
intersession days (winter,  
spring, summer break)

## Components

Before school, after  
school, or before and  
after school

## Hours

school hours + ELO-P  
hours = no less than 9  
hours/day

## Location

At school and/or  
community sites



# Who participates in ELO-P?



ELO-P is offered free of charge to Unduplicated (UPP) students, which include ELL, FY, and NSLP.

---



We are required to service at least 50% of UPP students at each school site.

---



When a student qualifies for ELO-P, they are qualified for the entire school year.

# ELO-Program Elements

1

Academic: Built in time Monday-Thursday for every student to complete their homework.

Enrichment: Curriculum built of weekly thematic units. “Fun Fridays” that include either an art or STEAM culminating activity.
