6.0 Administrator/Counseling Report

Kelly Welch - Quarter 1 ended 10/20. Grades were analyzed the following week to see where more intervention and support is needed for students with low grades. Math and English intervention is happening during CREW and homework help is available in the teacher's classrooms during lunch. Schoolwide, 76% of students are passing math with a C or better and 83% of students are passing English with a C or better. Today is a Renaissance Reward after school for students who earned Renaissance for Quarter 1.

Karla DiDomizio - Semester 1 ends before winter break. Final grades to be posted after winter break. Updates to come on grading for mastery from the English department. ESSR funds include Achieve 3,000, IXL for English and Math, interventions during lunch,

technology updates, field trips, and campus supervisors. Future Bears Night is 11/30 in the auditorium.

IB updates and *projected timeline* for the next 3 years. IB training for teachers throughout the 23/24 school year, Unit Planners (teacher planners for content standards) 24/25, and IB sitewide implementation 25/26 (changes to how Discover looks will take place this school year). Idea is to grade students on what they know and not what they do. Students are allowed to request to reassess for all graded assignments to show mastery.
