


# Selecting a Math Class


### Refer to these <u>flowcharts</u>:

The chart below indicates typical COLLEGE PREP course progressions for students who take Algebra 1 CP or Algebra 1A/1B during their freshman year. Students typically take one math course per year so they end up with the fourth math class in the sequence during their senior year. Pay attention to prerequisites! Any deviation from a math sequence should be discussed with the Math Department Chair and your counselor.

Students typically take one math course per year so that they end up with the fourth math class of the sequence during their senior year. Pay close attention to the prerequisites! 

### Health & Careers/Geography

**Health and Careers/Geography is a REQUIRED course for graduation.** MOST students will be taking at NPHS as freshmen during the school day. Health is a 18-week course, and Careers/Geography is a 18-week course. Exceptions to the health & careers/geography combo are:

- Students who opt for a period 7 health class
- Students who take Health in Summer School note that, although taking Health in Summer School "opens up" a space in the schedule for another elective, *no specific elective is guaranteed* (and NPHS gives elective priority to upperclassmen first and incoming freshmen last)
- Summer School Options <u>Your Responsibility to ensure accreditation</u>.

### **H/AP Classes**

For all students looking to challenge themselves with an AP/H class :

- If currently enrolled in an honors course, a B- or higher is needed to continue at that level
- If currently enrolled in a CP (college-prep) course, two A's are needed to move up a level
- If neither of the above occur, then an <u>academic waiver</u> will need to be filed. Placement may occur only on a space-available basis.
- If a student requests to level change FROM H/AP into CP *after* the school year begins, it will be on a space-available basis (that means a student may not be able to level change if there are no seats...and the student may have to stay in the H/AP class or find an alternative such as a study hall or TA position).

In short...CHOOSE WISELY!

### **D** or **F G**rades

- Unlike middle school, if a student in high school earns an F in any course required for graduation, the course must be repeated.
- Students who plan to go directly to a 4-year college will need to repeat any D grade to be MINIMALLY eligible (and to improve GPA).

Seniors should earn C grades or better!

### **Remediating D or F Grades**

- Summer School
  - Conejo Unified School District (remediation)
  - Any accredited school YOU choose up to 40 credits
  - Community College
- It is YOUR responsibility if you decide to pursue an online class: You need to find out accreditation, have the transcript mailed to NPHS registrar, register on your own, NCAA, UC A-G approval, etc.

### International Baccalaureate

- Program for highly motivated juniors and seniors
- Offers in-depth coursework at university level
- Students who wish to take IB-level courses in all disciplines (English, 2<sup>nd</sup> language, history, science, math and an elective) should consider the IB Diploma
