







Guidelines for AP/H/IB

For all 11th graders looking to challenge themselves with an AP/H/IB class as a senior:

- If currently enrolled in AP/H/IB class, a B- or higher is needed to continue at that level
- If currently enrolled in a CP (college prep) course, two A's are needed to move up a level
- If neither of the above occur, then an academic waiver will need to be filed. Placement may only occur on a space availability basis.


WHY TAKE PERIOD 7?

- Start school later or leave early! Students with period 7 could start school ~10:30am every other day.



Dual Enrollment

What is dual enrollment?



High school credit

Earn HS and college credits at the same time



College credit

Creates a permanent college transcript, save money, get used to college-style courses, transfers differently



Explore options

The VCCC offers a range of options beyond what is offered at the HS sites



Off-Site

An off-site DE course can count as one of your NPHS periods

Same weight assigned to DE as to Honors/AP/IB in NPHS GPA calculation

D or F Grades

- If an F grade is earned in any course required for high school graduation, the course must be repeated.
- Students who plan to go directly to a 4-year college are strongly advised to repeat any D grade to be eligible and to improve GPA.

For CSU/UC Admission

Students who earn a D or F grade in an A-G course that is required for admission will need to repeat the course to remain eligible for CSU/UC (exceptions include math and world language IF the D was earned FIRST semester and a C or higher was earned the SECOND semester).

During 12th grade, students that receive a D or F grade in any course, including AP and non A-G courses, may be at risk of having their admission rescinded.





NPHS Course Selection Guidelines

Schedule changes will **not** be made to accommodate teacher requests, period requests, extracurricular or athletic activities.

A required schedule change will be made for a student who failed a course or who completed a pre-approved summer school course.

A requested schedule change will be made only if it improves the integrity of your schedule for graduation or college entrance requirements **AND** if there is space available. Schedule change requests can be addressed in August during Schedule Pick-Up Day.

Athletics

If you play a NPHS team sport, you will earn 5 credits each season toward your 20-credit PE requirement. 




