**Course Description:**

What is AVID?

AVID is a 9th grade elective class that rotates with a core academic class. It is a yearlong class that focuses on:

-Skills for high school, college and career success, academic and life goal setting, cultural and college field trips, guest speakers, team building, and collaboration.

-Delivering cross-curricular academic instruction in writing, effective note taking, study skills, test-taking strategies, organizational strategies and materials (provided), and critical thinking.

-Providing weekly academic support through collaborative tutorial groups.

The AVID student is one who has a 2.0-3.5 GPA in mainly college preparatory level classes, is motivated to maintain a C or better in all their classes, strives to go to college, commits to remaining in the class all year, is receptive to help with material and skill based organization and has the desire and determination to succeed at school and beyond.

AVID is an elective (voluntary) class, but students must have the desire to be in the class and commit to enrollment for the entire school year as it will be paired with a required academic rotating class. AVID is not an intervention or remedial class. AVID is an A-G elective that is recognized by the UC and Cal State College system. Students must fit the 2.0-3.5 GPA requirement.
