

COURSE TITLE: Anatomy CP

Course Description:

In this course you will be introduced to the structure (anatomy) and function (physiology) of the human body in an effort to acquire an integrated view of how the human body works. The larger concepts of homeostasis and maintenance of the internal environment will be emphasized. Students will explore these topics through discussions, laboratory investigations, teacher lecture, in-class assignments, and dissections. This course assumes an understanding of fundamental biological concepts and is aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards in Biology.

Grading:

The grading system is based on weighted categories. Each assignment will have a point value within the weighted category. Assessments are weighted much more heavily than in-class work and homework. Individual teachers may make modifications on the weighted percentages.
