

COURSE TITLE: Art Media

Course Description:

This class is designed to introduce the general student population to the historical and cultural background of the visual arts. Art Media is the foundation course for all other art courses. This is accomplished by exploring individual art expression in drawing, painting, sculpture, design, portraiture, and collage. Students will learn the Elements of Art and Principles of Design as a basis for all projects. Materials cost for projects that students keep. Art Kits available for purchase at Student Store.

Grading:

30% of the student's grade comes from "Practice Work" (sketchbook, in class practice exercises, etc.).

50% of the student's grade comes from "Projects," which are major projects.

20% of the student's grade comes from "Work Habits," which includes the student's ability to use the valuable class time and resources wisely.
