

COURSE TITLE: Financial Math- Hybrid

Course Description:

This hybrid course is designed to provide students with real-world life skills in financial literacy. Students must attend at least one class on campus to meet attendance requirements. The course emphasizes applications of math in life rather than computations. The use of a calculator is encouraged. Topics include: budgeting, savings, credit cards, loans, bargain shopping, investments, insurance, and taxes. The class format is hybrid with about five hours of work submitted weekly. Assignments will include watching videos, reading, and submitting assignments and quizzes.
