Course Description:

This class is designed to be the capstone course to your Technical Theatre education at Newbury Park High School. It allows you to specialize in a chosen field of theatrical lighting, audio production, set construction, stage management, property management, stage rigging or costume design, and take that knowledge more professional level. Students will be given hands on experience in a real theatre with theatrical production work design, internship opportunities with professional and community theatre companies, and in class production projects. Stage Production students are expected to design elements for the theatrical productions, in addition to providing technical support and design, as necessary, for other events on campus, such as Dance Concerts, Choir events, Band Festivals, Talent Shows, etc. Students will also be expected to serve in a leadership capacity and mentor students in the Technical Theatre class. Students in this course will be ready to work professionally in the entertainment industry, enabling students to work as an entry-level technician or stagehand. **Grading:**
