Course Description:

- 2) Period 3 1 semester, block class; recommended for students wishing to pursue strings and sports

With instructor permission, students participating in a sport may be allowed to enroll in the 5th period String Orchestra during the time they are not involved with athletics. They will be allowed to add/drop the class throughout the year depending on their sport.
