


Learning Model Preference Survey Results





- CVUSD schools will employ “Traditional” model and go back to full-day Board approved schedules. (Consent Agenda 4P)
- Await State legislation and guidance on “Independent Study” requirements for 2021-2022 school year - Virtual Program
