 - "Any meeting held by a council or committee shall be open to the public, and any member of the public shall be able to address the council or committee during the meeting on any item within the subject matter jurisdiction of the council or committee."
 - "Notice of the meeting shall be posted at the school site, or other appropriate place accessible to the public, at least 72 hours before the time set for the meeting."
 - "The notice shall specify the date, time, and location of the meeting and contain an agenda describing each item of business to be discussed or acted upon."
 - "Any materials provided to a school site council shall be made available to any member of the public who requests the materials pursuant to the California Public Records Act."
