  - ➤ Aspen SPSA Update
    - Elementary Education is reviewing our SPSA and mainly looking at balancing funds currently
    - Chronic Absenteeism is a major focus of the District this year
      - As of today, we're at 5% chronic absenteeism (which is missing 10% or more of the to date school days)
      - We're closing watching our students with disabilities (which we were flagged for last year) and offering what services we can to help them out.
  - > Intervention Update
    - One of our Intervention teachers was offered a full time teaching position, which she accepted, so we are down to one currently
    - We are posting the open position through our District
    - Intervention starts tomorrow
    - It is planned to run until Memorial Day weekend
