Dear CVUSD Elementary School Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to share with you that CVUSD is offering a Summer Learning Camp (SLC) again this summer! You are receiving this letter because we would like to invite your student to participate. Student identification for SLC was based upon your student's 2nd trimester benchmark scores, report card, teacher and principal recommendations, and overall academic progress this past school year.

SLC is for students currently in grades K-4. It will provide additional learning time in Reading, Writing, Math and social-emotional skills. This year CVUSD is partnering with Learn4Life and Antelope Valley Learning Academy to provide elementary summer school as we did last year. We will still have CVUSD teachers and staff, and the daily program will look and feel the same, but all students will need a Master Agreement form on file to complete their enrollment.

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We will use Scholastic Lit Camp curriculum to read and enjoy many books together and also provide instruction and practice to strengthen your student's foundational reading and math skills. Students will use Lexia Reading and IXL Math software for individual skill practice and lessons. There will be a snack/recess time as well as art, fitness, and fun activities throughout the morning. Students will get a camp t-shirt they can wear any day of the week, and there will also be spirit days. Students will have the option to take a free school lunch home at the end of the day.
