

General Information About TK & K



Enrollment in TK and K

- Beginning, January 30, 2023, visit the CVUSD website at <u>https://conejo.vcoe.org/preenrollment/</u> and follow the instructions on pre-enrollment.
- You will complete the pre-enrollment process online and save, then email the final page to the office manager at your neighborhood school. They will provide further instructions to complete the enrollment process. Paper enrollment packets will also be available at all school sites and at the District Office, in the Student Support Services Department.
- Enrollment begins at your neighborhood school for TK and K, even if you apply for school choice. For the 23-24 school year all schools, except EARThS Magnet have TK classes.
- New Website look for the "enrollment" button.

Immunizations



According to California Legislation:

- California schools are required to check immunization records for all new student admissions at TK/Kindergarten. Parents must show their child's Immunization Record as proof of immunization.

TK and K Enrollment Information

Enrollment for TK and K for the 23-24 school year will be at every neighborhood school site this year.

Final decisions on how many TK and K classes will be at each site will be made in the Spring based on enrollment

TK and K Age Requirements

Transitional Kindergarten - Turning 5 between 9/02/2023 through 4/2/2024.

Kindergarten - Must turn 5 by 9/01/2023. Students that turn 5 on 9/02/2023 will enroll in TK.

TK & Kindergarten



The first years of schooling are critical ones. In transitional kindergarten through grade one, children acquire the skills, knowledge, and dispositions that establish the foundation for a lifetime of learning. Children achieve these skills and understandings through carefully specified and strategically sequenced instruction and rich, authentic experiences in a developmentally appropriate environment.

Transitional Kindergarten

A Day in TK

- Self-directed play opportunities
- Uninterrupted choice time
- Outdoor times including recess and lunch
- Exposure to letters, sounds and numbers
- Purposeful play
- Direct instruction in academic topics
- 1:12 ratio with a full time an aide in every class

- Developmentally appropriate learning
- Oral language and literacy development
- Social emotional development

Kindergarten

A Day in K

- Standards-based instruction
- Direct instruction in all academic areas
- Small group centers and rotations
- Hands-on learning to build understanding
- Recess and lunch in outdoor play areas
- Art activities with different mediums



Ongoing Development

- Building confidence in literacy and math skills
- Fine motor skills like cutting, coloring, gluing, drawing and printing
- District benchmarks for essential skills
- Social emotional learning and activities
- Relationship skills with peers
- Problem solving skills

Student Supports

Special Education

- Students with a disability are provided direct services to support their unique learning needs
- Each elementary school site has a special education teacher
- If a child's disability requires a higher level of services, CVUSD does offer specialized programs for TK age students

English Learners

- Students whose primary language is other than English, integrated and designated services are provided
- Strengthen their English speaking, writing and comprehension skills
- Bilingual paraeducators and facilitators are at each elementary site

School Choice



School Choice

All of Conejo Valley Unified Schools are considered Schools of Choice. As long as a school is not filled to its capacity with existing students and incoming neighborhood students, students living outside the neighborhood boundaries of a school may apply to enroll in that school.

*TK students accepted on School Choice will stay at that school for K-5. To return to your neighborhood school you would need to school choice back.

School Choice Timeline

November 1, 2022	School Choice Applications available	
January 31, 2023	School Choice Applications for lottery eligibility are due by 11:59 PM	
March 16, 2023	Decision letters emailed to families	
August 17, 2023	Last day to apply via School Choice for a CVUSD elementary school and middle school	
September 30, 2023	School Choice Waitlist is cancelled	

Extended TK

Students with birth dates of April 3 - May 31, 2019

- These students will be given an opportunity to request placement in TK for the 23-24 school year.
- These placements will happen throughout the summer and even in the days after school starts based on space availability.
- Families will be offered attendance at schools that will most likely not be their neighborhood school.
- Families will have 24 hours to decide if they want to attend the offered school.


