#### **Anonymous Question Box Guidelines:**



- No Names. Questions are anonymous and are not to be used to hurt or embarrass others. Questions with names on them will not be read out loud.
- No Personal Questions of the Instructor
- Nobody can take anything out to the Question Box, except for the instructor

#### **Sexual Consent**


- 1) Both partners are 18 or older (in CA)
