Your student is registered to attend the CVUSD summer school program administered by The Learn for Life Program through Antelope Valley Learning Academy Charter. The goal is to provide academic support in the area/s of: English, Math, and/or English Language Development. Some students will have the opportunity to participate in an Enrichment class. Pass/Fail grades will be assigned for all courses taken.

Please read all the information below related to expectations, general schedule, training for students and expected participation. <u>All classes for 2025 Summer School will be in person for all students.</u>

ABSENCES

- Students are strongly encouraged to attend all classes in which they are enrolled. To report an absence please contact the Redwood Middle School front office at (805)497-7264.
- Please make sure to communicate with your student's teacher to get details for make-up work that is required.

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES:

- <u>STEP ONE</u>: Teacher will conference with the student and contact parent/guardian.
- <u>STEP TWO</u>: Teacher will refer student to the office. The Principal or Assistant Principal will contact parent/guardian and warn student that the next violation will result in removal from the Summer School program.
- <u>STEP THREE</u>: The Principal or Assistant Principal will meet with the student and, at his/her discretion, may recommend the removal of that student from the Summer School program.

ADDITIONAL DISCIPLINE POLICIES:

- Students are expected to obey all District, school, and classroom rules.
- Any violation of the CVUSD Zero Tolerance Policy on possession/use of weapons or explosives, or the possession or selling of illegal substances on or near the campus will result in the immediate removal of that student from the Summer School program, notification of incident to law enforcement and recommendation for expulsion from the CVUSD.
- Any student involved in a fight during the Summer School term will be immediately removed from the Summer School program.
- A student may be dropped from Summer School for the following additional reasons:
 - Violations of the Academic Honesty Policy.
 - Tobacco products, vape or smokeless devices on campus.
 - Students will receive a Pass/Fail grade; excessive tardies/absences could result in a Fail.
