2. OPEN SESSION

A. Call the Meeting to Order and Roll Call

Vice President Gorback asked for a moment of silence after the Pledge of Allegiance in honor of the recent passing of NPHS Softball Coach Mike Dagan.

Trustee Sylvester made the motion to approve, seconded by Trustee Goldberg. There was no Board discussion on this agenda item. **Motion carried: 5-0, with an honorary "yes" vote from Student Trustee Xu.**

B. Student Services – Adoption of Resolution #21/22-05 for National Bullying Prevention Month

Trustee Goldberg made the motion to approve, seconded by Trustee Sylvester. Vice President Gorback asked for follow up from District staff on how each site is honoring this resolution. There was no Board discussion on this agenda item. **Motion carried: 5-0, with an honorary "yes" vote from Student Trustee Xu.**
