WHEREAS, credentialed school nurses are in a specialized practice of professional nursing that advance and promote the well-being, academic success, health and life-long achievements of all students by serving on the frontlines and providing a critical safety net for our nation's most fragile children; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Conejo Valley Unified School District hereby recognizes May 12, 2021, as National School Nurse Day.
